Sir,

Please refer to your RTI application (Regn. No.MOSPI/R/2014/80007) dated 16.01.2014, seeking information inter alia on MPLADS fund allocation/utilisation in respect of Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha MPs from Kerala.

2. So far as the Members of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS) of the Govt. of India administered by Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation is concerned, the information is as under:-

Under the Members of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS), funds are directly sent to the nodal district authorities of the MPs who examine and implement the eligible developmental works recommended by the Members of the Parliament and maintain details of individual works executed and amount spent under the scheme. The Ministry only receives the cumulative information on the works recommended, sanctioned, expenditure incurred etc. through the monthly progress reports (MPRs). The cumulative details of fund released and expenditure incurred is in public domain and is available on the website: [www.mplads.gov.in](http://www.mplads.gov.in) (under head: release/expenditure).

As uploaded by the nodal district authority the cost/place of sanctioned works, status of works sanctioned/completed, etc. can be viewed on the website: [www.mplads.gov.in](http://www.mplads.gov.in) (under head: Works Monitoring System-MPLADS Reports-MP wise/constituency wise).


3. For getting any further information on works recommended, sanctioned and fund utilisation, etc. of different MPs, you may apply separately to the nodal district authorities concerned of the MPs, as stipulated in para 3(iii) of DOPT's O.M. No.10/2/2008-IR dated 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2008 on RTI applications which, inter alia, states that if 'a person makes an application to a public authority for information, a part of which is available with that public authority and the rest of the information is scattered with more than one other public authority, in such a case, the PIO of the public authority receiving the application should give information relating to it and advise the applicant to make separate applications to the concerned public authorities for obtaining information from them. If no part of the information sought, is available with it but is scattered with more than one other public authorities, the PIO should inform the applicant that information is not available with the public authority and that the applicant should make separate applications to the concerned public authorities for obtaining from them.

*It may be noted that the Act requires the supply of such information only which already exists and is held by the public authority or held under the control of the public authority. It is beyond the scope of the Act for a public authority to create information.'*
